Things to know, if you decide to hunt with us

Those who are flying in to Deer Lake, should ensure that they arrive in Deer Lake on time to connect with our camp changeover time. If you are going to hunt Leslie Lake, Matties Pond, Stephens Pond, you have to be in Deer Lake on Saturday morning. If you are flying in, please do so on Friday. If you are driving here, take the ferry on Friday and meet me at the Deer Lake Motel on Saturday morning. If you are hunting at Partridge Pond you should be at Parsons Pond on Friday evening. We fly into Big Pond and Mouse Pond on Sunday. Hunters going there should fly in to Deer Lake on Saturday. If driving, take the ferry on Saturday and meet me at Peter Strides on Sunday morning at approximately 10:30 AM. Arrival back from camp is one week later.

If you need accommodations in Deer Lake on the night of your arrival, you should make reservations before you leave home (well in advance). Telephone number is (709 635-2018 - Deer Lake Motel). When you arrive in Deer Lake, ask for a cab from Deer Lake Taxi. They will take you to Deer Lake Motel. If you have any problems upon arrive, my cell phone number is (709) 458-7420 and my home number is (709) 243-7207.

We would appreciate you having all of your possessions in two or three small bags, if possible. Place any beverages inside cardboard boxes or carrying cases. In order to transport your firearm to and from camp, please use a **soft gun case**. We will take care of your hard gun case. Make sure you know the dates of your hunt and let me know the time of your arrival.

If you owe any monies, upon arrival please have it in the form of travelers cheques, certified cheque or cash.

THINGS YOU WILL NEED

You will need cash or travelers cheques for motels, tips, meals, meat butchering, meat packing (for those who are flying home) and shipping of meat. Cost of butchering is 50 cents per pound.

By now, you should have a firearms declaration. Fill it out but **don't** sign it until you get to Customs. It will cost \$50.00 Canadian.

Bring good rain clothes, rubber boots, (12 to 16 inches high) a warm vest, and a jacket. A pair of slippers or light shoes (for camp) and other clothes you may need for a week, sleeping bag, towels, camera, and binoculars.

If you need a map or firearms papers, please let me know.

If you have any health problems or food allergies, please let me know.
